Just a few reminders....

Please call family housing phone directly- we will no longer be transferring tenants to the family housing line, 780-624-2093. If I am unavailable, I am also unavailable on the main line. Please also remember to leave a message; I try my best to return calls in 2 business days. However, you may call the main line for maintenance requests.

Rent is due on the first of each month; we have a 3 business day grace period for late rent. Anything after those three business days will have a \$50 late charge. Tenants receiving more than one eviction notice in a row will receive an eviction for breach of their lease, or there is a possibility of a court ordered eviction. It is especially important that tenants budget accordingly with Christmas coming up.

The adjustment deadline for September income is October 14th. Anything submitted afterwards will not be considered.

Rent is due on the 1st of each month. It is a substantial breach of your lease to consistently pay your rent late and you can be given an irrevocable eviction.

Maintenance tip

Make sure that you know where the water shut off is in your unit. In case of a water emergency this could save your unit from a great deal of damage. The water shut off in a house or duplex is in the basement on the water meter. In a town house (row of three units or more) it is in the basement ceiling. If you have a crawl space it will be in there. Please be aware of where your water shut off is before an emergency happens. If you cannot find it please give us a call and we will walk through it with you.



- Plan your route or have a meeting point and time decided upon before hand
- Wear reflective type clothing or have a light with you.
- Don't hide or cross the street behind parked cars.
- Only visit homes that have the porch light on.
- Use a light stick instead of a wick in pumpkins.
- Accept treats at the door and never go into a stranger's house.
- Have a grown up inspect your treats when you get home.
